



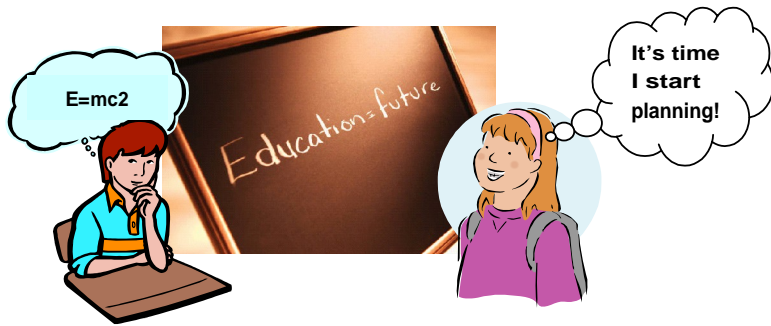
CAREER PATHWAYS ASSIGNMENT
